It is recommended that the bid be awarded to Alaska Sure Seal in the amount of \$24,772.50. This will be a total of 15,750 lbs of applied joint crack sealant.

In addition, the administration recommends that council approve a change order in an amount not to exceed \$10,000, to provide crack sealing services at the airport. As part of the development of the pavement maintenance plan for the airport, Scott Hattenburg of Hattenburg Dilley and Linnell, LLC, examined the condition of the cracks in runway 16/34. He recommended that the City seal the worst of the cracks this summer. He estimates that the worst of the cracks on the runway could be sealed by the contractor for \$6,000 to \$10,000. This would be a "Band-Aid approach" as these cracks may have to be re-sealed when the complete crack sealing job is done at the airport, anticipated for summer 2014.

Alaska Sure Seal uses a different product from the sealant previously used at the airport. The two products may not bond permanently to each other, resulting in reduced lifespan for the product to be applied by Alaska Sure Seal. A proper application would involve removal of the old product before application of the new.

The alternative of going out for a separate bid for this rudimentary airport crack sealing will require a Request for Proposals to be written and issued, pursuant to the purchasing regulations in PMC 3.21. This will add several weeks to the process and may place the project beyond acceptable the acceptable weather timeframe.

Administration recommendation: Approve action memorandum 13-048.
